General Facts

The OCCC is funded by Orange County tourist development tax (resort tax) collections.

Orange County Convention Center’s Phase V Project is the largest public project in Orange County history.

In 1983, the Center hosted 129 events with 342,982 attendees whose spending contributed to an annual economic impact of \$26.2 million. In fiscal year 2005, the OCCC hosted 259 events and more than 1.4 million attendees. The spending of these attendees contributes to the annual economic impact of \$1.4 billion the Orange County Convention Center has on the local community.

As of April 1, 2006, there are 967 events with an estimated 13 million attendees booked through the year 2028. This will generate approximately \$13.8 billion in delegate spending during this time frame.

Orange County Convention Center (OCCC) provides over \$1 billion in economic impact to Central Florida annually, supporting over 1,000 local businesses. Additionally, 26,000 jobs are created, 15,000 hotel rooms generated and 1.6 million attendees and guests come to Orlando.

The first show in the North/South Complex was Surf Expo in September 2003, and the first show open to the general public was the Orlando Home Show.
